If granted, this permit is subject to the following conditions, requirements, and covenants, to wit:

1. Applications for road crossing must be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners no later than 5 days before a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. The Applicant, his engineer, contractor or other designee shall contact The County Commissioners at the completion of the crossing for an onsite inspection. Contact information:

- 2. Applications for Fast Line (Temporary Installation) are only valid for sixty (60) days from date of approval. Upon expiration of the sixty (60) days, applicant must reapply for a permit and pay the applicable application fee.
- 3. The applicant must agree to hold McClain County harmless for any damage or injury to persons or property caused by or resulting from the construction, maintenance, operation, or repair of the facilities on, under, or over the county right-of-way, and shall return the right of way or other area in which work was performed to its original, or better condition.
- 4. All crossings shall be bored. Blasting is not permitted.
- 5. When paralleling the roadway, utility lines shall be located within 4 feet of the R/W line or the fence line, if a fence is in place. If no fence exists, the R/W lines shall be located by an Oklahoma Registered Land Surveyor at the applicant's expense. A copy of such survey shall be provided to the Board prior to permit being granted. In no instance shall a utility line be placed within the limits of the roadbed. All underground parallel installations shall be a minimum of thirty (30) inches deep, except power which should be placed at a minimum depth of forty-eight (48) inches below the surface. All overhead parallel installations shall not cross any point of access to the county road at a height of less than eighteen (18) feet.
- 6. Applicant agrees to keep the road open to traffic unless otherwise agreed to or approved by the Board of County Commissioners. When notified to do so by the Board of County Commissioners the petitioner/contractor agrees, at expense, to make all changes in the facility on county right-of-way. Utility and pipelines shall not interfere with the maintenance of county right of way. McClain County is not liable for any damage to utility or pipeline within right-of-way due to interference with road maintenance.
- 7. Aerial Facilities-Applicant agrees to erect any overhead lines to the clearance height and other rules of construction as prescribed by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.
- 8. Applicant agrees to increase by one (1) wall thickness all steel pipe and all other pipe will be sleeved (cased) at each road crossing.
- 9. All underground crossings shall be a minimum of four (4) feet below the elevation of the center line of the road or two (2) feet below the elevation of the ditch, whichever is greater. High pressure gas line crossings shall be a minimum of four (4) feet below the elevation of the ditch.
- 10. All section corners and ¼ section corners shall be protected. No pipeline or utility line shall cross an intersection diagonally. No lines shall cross within 50 feet of a ¼ section corner or 100' of a bridge.
