A new and revised Pipeline Safety and Incident Management program for Emergency Responders.

- Not all pipelines are OPAL
- Pipeline Basics: 1" Low pressure
42" High pressure
No batching in McClain County
Separated by density
npms.phmsa.dot.gov: red – natural gas
Blue – liquid gas
Transmission Pipelines only
- Emergency Preparedness – Know what products are being transported; leak recognition (Sight-Sound-Smell)
- Incident Response – Assess situation and secure the area. Protect People & Property. Work with Pipeline Operators
- Damage Prevention – **Call OKIE (dial 811)**. You are responsible for damage. **811** is also used for emergency number. **They notify ALL pipelines**
- OPAL utilizes Unified Command
- okpipelineawareness.com
- There are 4 ONEOK divisions.
