

Need an Address in McClain County? You MUST Have a Permit First!

Questions about Development or Dividing Property Lots in McClain County? You MUST have a permit before you can be assigned an address! The local post Offices DO NOT issue addresses. In jurisdictions not listed below, your first step is to contact the **McClain County Floodplain Administration!**

Town of Goldsby	Town Administrator (405)288-6675	Issues own permits and addresses property within the town limits.
City of Newcastle	City Planning Department (405)365-6210	Issues own permits and addresses property within the city limits.
City of Purcell	Code Enforcement (405)527-4656	Issues own permits and addresses property within the city limits.
