- **Call to Order**

- **Emergency Management Report**

- **Blanchard** – EM not available. McClain County Health Department has bought property in Blanchard to relocate Health Department clinic. This property has a 40' x 70' storage building in which an agreement has been reached for the county to utilize this space for EM storage.
- **Purcell :**
 - Completed Storm shelter grant for the City of Purcell. Taylor Smith with Red Cross said there is a Grants Manager with the ARC that also has money to contribute to any community that has the Grant Process in place. Will e-mail Ed the information.
 - Also has prepared Notice of Intend (NOI) to develop a drainage plan for the City of Purcell with a cost of \$3 Million.
- **Newcastle-**
 - 3 outdoor sirens are on order
 - 2 cameras are planned at the Newcastle Shelter and SE part of the City (at Water Tower). Plan is to use for weather and wildfires. The plan is to use funding received from the 2012 tornado to consider shelters for the DVRs for the remote cameras
 - 2 Weather Stations are planned at the Shelter and South of the City.
 - Newcastle was one of two groups (Newcastle and Norman) that participated in the CERT Rodeo put on in Edmond last month. Jon stated that it was an EXCELLENT TRAINING.
 - Newcastle has received funding from a grant to be used for CERT equipment.
 - They have awarded grant money to 92 shelters
 - Currently improving the lot for the EM program in the city.
- **Goldsby** – No report
- **Wayne** – Recent and current flooding from this morning's rainfall. Multipurpose room in town flooded this morning
- **Byars** – No report.

- **McClain County :**
 - Hazardous Mitigation plan to be reviewed by contractor and should be ready next month.
 - Making credentialing cards. MUST have documentation of credentials on file to put on card.
 - Attending Salamander Training in OKC with exercise this afternoon

-Currently in the process of ordering Fuel Trainer (2-110 gallon tanks for gasoline, and 1-110 gallon tank for diesel). This was tabled by the County Commissioners this week to determine licensing requirements. Jorge suggested that Ed call the Motor Fuel division of the Corporation Commission.

-McCART: Should be getting the McCART Equipment Trailer in late August or September. Plan to show it at the Annual OEM meeting. The trailer comes fully equipped. McCART also has kennels found by Kevin at a local Fire Station and brought to McCART. May utilize space in Blanchard for this storage.

- **McCART Report**

- **Purcell Hospital** – Currently have 8 people as Certified in HAZ WOPER (Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response) Also have 30 people listed as Awareness in HAZ WOPER.
- **MRC Business** – Volunteers State workshop on Friday & Saturday, August 1 & 2 in OKC. Reviewed how to get on website www.OKMRC.org to review agenda and schedule, also on how to sign up for MRC. There will be animal response training, Psychological First Aide training, and immunization training for nurses.
- **Red Cross Report** – Jeff asked if anyone was having trouble getting in contact with the Red Cross and if so, to contact him. Norman office phone number is 405-321-0591, after hours number is 405-228-9500. You can call the Norman office at any time, and it should relay the call to the off hours contact.
- **Trainings** – Jon will be teaching First Aid at the CERT classes this weekend at MNTC.

Western Shelter Training: Contact Amy Allen or Paulette to schedule. Those participants will receive 2 hours of CLEET training. These are A/C units that are being used for cooling stations, rehydration stations, and can be used with wildfires as a rehab station.
